**Subject:** Consider approval of an Ordinance establishing paid parking at Burleson

Park for SMU football game days

#### Background:

In November 2023, the City Council appointed a task force made up of property owners, merchants, and residents to provide recommendations on parking options for employees of Snider Plaza. As the task force studied the issue, their recommendation evolved into consideration of paid parking for Snider Plaza and other areas of the community.

In March, the task force presented this modified recommendation to the City Council and Council postponed action on the item. While the comprehensive topic of paid parking is still being studied, staff would like to propose implementation of game day parking at Burleson Park with the upcoming SMU football season.

Currently, all parking around the park is restricted to 2-hour only. On SMU football game days, the lot across the street from Burleson Park is used for parking at a rate of \$25-\$30.

There are five remaining home games scheduled at SMU for the 2025 season:

- September 6 vs. Baylor
- October 4 vs. Syracuse
- October 11 vs. Stanford
- November 1 vs. Miami
- November 22 vs. Louisville

With improvements at Centennial Park currently underway, some programming will shift to Burleson Park and may conflict with SMU game days. Staff recommends designating a number of spaces around the park for recreation/programming. Meanwhile, any additional spaces could be considered for paid parking.

Staff brought this item to the Parks Advisory Committee for consideration on August 21. The committee recommendation is to implement game day parking at Burleson Park this year as a pilot program. An Ordinance will be provided prior to the Council Meeting.
