Subject: Opioid Settlement – 8 opioids manufacturers

Background:

A new proposed national opioids settlement has been reached with eight opioids manufacturers: Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus. This settlement provides for payments to the City for opioid abatement. The funds received by the City must be used to support a variety of strategies to fight the opioid crisis. The Attorney General's Office confirms the City's use of settlement proceeds is eligible towards education programming supporting the middle school DARE program.

The City has opted to participate in several other opioids settlements and has received \$19,062.17 in distributions to date:

November 2021 J&J, Teva, and Endo

March 2023 Allergan, CVS, Walmart, and Walgreens

December 2024 Kroger

August 2025 Purdue Pharma and the Sackler Family

To participate in this new direct settlement with the eight opioids manufacturers, the City needs to "opt in" by submitting the Subdivision Participation Form to participate in the direct settlement to the Texas Attorney General's Office by October 8, 2025.
