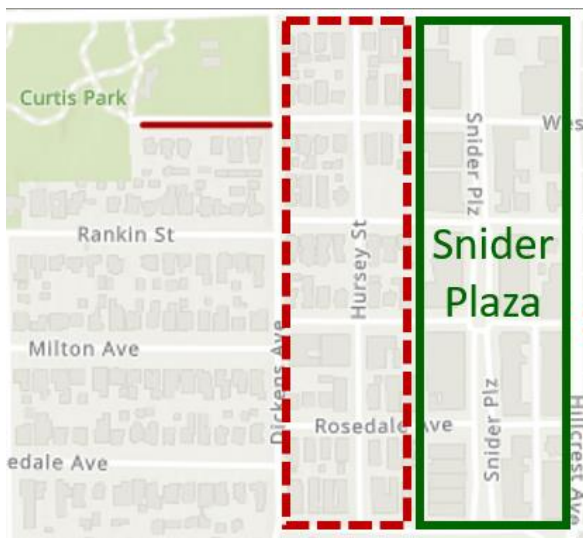
Subject: Discuss establishing a Resident Parking District in the residential area just west of Snider Plaza

Background: In November of 2023, the City Council appointed a task force of Snider Plaza merchants, Snider Plaza property owners, and nearby residents to study how best to provide parking for employees of Snider Plaza businesses. The task force has met regularly since this time.

A consistent theme throughout task force discussions has been providing some relief to residents who live just west of Snider Plaza, in the area bounded by Lovers, Dickens, Daniel, and the alley on the west side of Snider Plaza (see map below). Currently, a number of Snider Plaza employees park along these residential streets. While the task force is still considering options for employee parking, they would recommend initiating the process for establishing a Resident Parking District.

Staff is requesting that City Council discuss this item and provide direction. If Council is amenable to the request for a new parking district, staff will begin the standard process of surveying residents in the proposed area. Upon completion of the survey, staff will return to City Council for consideration of an Ordinance to formally establish the Resident Parking District.
