### **Background:**

The Regional Transportation Council (RTC) oversees the metropolitan transportation planning process, including:

- Guiding the development of multimodal transportation plans and programs.
- Determining the allocation of federal, state and regional transportation funds.
- Selecting transportation projects in some programs and recommending projects to the Texas Transportation Commission for other programs.
- Ensuring transportation providers coordinate services
- Ensuring the metropolitan area complies with state and federal laws and regulations regarding transportation and air quality.

The City of Dallas, Town of Highland Park and City of University Park are a population cluster represented on the RTC by six primary members and up to six alternate members. The current representatives to the RTC are as follows:

HP Town Council Member Myers has served as an alternate since July 2022, and his current term ends June 30. Prior to that, Councilmember Mark Aldredge served as the alternate rep (2020 – 2022), and he was preceded by Councilmember Taylor Armstrong (2015 – 2022). The attached resolution will join the Town of Highland Park and the City of Dallas in the appointment of University Park Councilmember Darrell Lane to serve as

the alternate representative for the Cities to the Regional Transportation Council, with a two-year term beginning in July.
