Subject: Consider Award for Installation Services – Traffic Signal Equipment

Background:

Traffic signal equipment at these intersections needs to be upgraded:

- Lovers Lane / Airline Road
- Lovers Lane / Hillcrest Avenue
- Daniel Avenue / Airline Road
- Lovers Lane / Baltimore Drive
- Lovers Lane / Turtle Creek
- Preston Road / Glenwick Lane

The traffic detection cameras, aluminum signs, and cabling were purchased earlier this year and have arrived at 4419 Worcola Street. These need to be installed by professionals who have been trained on how to upgrade the City's brand of equipment. **Iteris, Inc. can provide the qualified labor via BuyBoard contract # 695-23 for a total amount of \$272,482.56.** If Council approves this request tonight, work will start around October 2nd and end in early January. One intersection will be updated at a time and each intersection will take one to two weeks to complete.

All BuyBoard contracts have been competitively bid and meet State procurement guidelines.
