Subject: Consider purchase of Digital Evidence Platform to include Fleet and Body

Cameras and two law enforcement drones

Background:

In November 2019, Council approved the purchase of Axon In-Car Cameras, Body Cameras and Interview Room Cameras for use by the Police Department. This equipment has been performing well but is nearing the end of its life cycle and 5-year Agreement with Axon. Recently the University Park Public Safety Advisory Committee (PSAC) met and reviewed a 10-year proposal from AXON that includes:

- New body cameras with replacement included at months 30, 60, 90, and 120
- New in-car cameras with replacement included at months 60 and 120
- Fleet 3 in-car cameras equipped with mobile License Plate Recognition
- ➤ 10 years of locked billing best pricing for 10 years
- 2 free law enforcement drones with 10 years free licensing and support
- State cooperative contract pricing

Advantages of law enforcement drones include:

- Search for a missing person
- Security at city events
- Surveying the scene of a weather-related catastrophe
- Monitoring and aiding the UPFD at the scene of a structure fire
- Active Shooter surveillance at a school/campus

The PSAC approved the 10-year proposed camera agreement from Axon with the addition of two drones.

The attached Axon quote in the amount of \$960,572.10 is payable in eleven (11) installments. The package includes full warranty coverage.
