**Subject:** CONSIDER AND ACT: Transfer of Fund Balances from SMU Land Sale

Fund into the General Government Capital Projects Fund

## Background:

The City of University Park is currently in the midst of construction of significant capital projects at both Snider Plaza and the public safety training facility at 5620 Fondren. Both of these are important projects that help the City progress on action items from the Centennial Master Plan.

The SMU Land Sale Fund is governed by the SMU Land Sale Reserve Committee. This committee reviews proposed expenditures from the SMU Land Sale Reserve Fund and makes a recommendation to the City Council.

The SMU Land Sale Reserve Committee met on May 22, 2025 and voted in support of the following transfer from the SMU Land Sale Reserve Fund to the Capital Projects Fund for the following expenditures:

- \$4,500,000 in support of construction expenses for a new public safety training and storage facility located at 5620 Fondren.
- \$1,000,000 in support of construction expenses providing a 53-space parking lot at property located at 3420 Rankin, near Snider Plaza

City staff prepared an Ordinance for City Council consideration that would formally adopt this transfer from the SMU Land Sale Fund to the General Government Capital Projects Fund.
