Subject: Consider an amendment to an Ordinance establishing paid parking at

Burleson Park for SMU football game days

Background:

During the September 2 City Council meeting, Council approved an Ordinance authorizing game day parking in the spaces adjacent to Burleson Park as part of a pilot program. The Ordinance also designated spaces on the Durham side for park-use only.

Currently the spaces around the park are 2-hour parking 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. SMU football games are traditionally scheduled on Saturdays when the 2-hour parking is not enforceable.

Staff is requesting the approved Ordinance be amended to include a 2-hour time restriction for the park-use only spaces along Durham on game days. This update would allow staff to more effectively monitor and enforce this park-use only designation.

There are four remaining home games scheduled at SMU for the 2025 season:

- October 4 vs. Syracuse
- October 11 vs. Stanford
- November 1 vs. Miami
- November 22 vs. Louisville

At the conclusion of the football season, staff will bring this item back to Council for a briefing on the game day pilot program.
