**Subject:** Consider approval of the proposal from Durable Specialties for the replacement of the Preston / Lovers traffic signal

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### **Background:**

The City has an annual capital project to upgrade all 33 traffic signals throughout the City. Design for the replacement of the signal at the Preston / Lovers intersection was completed in 2020. The design effort included an assessment of the location of signal components including the traffic signal cabinet. Multiple discussions between staff, City Council, the design engineer, Mayor Stewart and Bill Shaddock took place to confirm the placement of the new signal cabinet on the northeast corner of the intersection in Shaddock Park. The approval of the cabinet placement in the park resulted from these discussions. With this approval, staff would like to proceed with the signal replacement. Durable Specialties has an existing contract with the City of Richardson which the City can take advantage of due to an Interlocal Agreement between University Park and the City of Richardson. The attached proposal from Durable Contract is based on the City of Richardson contract and is in the amount of \$221,908.00. The City has already acquired the signal components and, upon approval of this contract, we anticipate construction to begin in November.
