WHEREAS, the City of University Park honors the dedicated sanitation employees who help keep our community clean, healthy, and beautiful; and

WHEREAS, through extreme heat, cold, rain, and other challenging conditions, University Park's sanitation employees work diligently year-round to provide essential services and enhance the quality of life for residents; and

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2025, University Park sanitation crews collected 17,041 tons of solid waste, with approximately 23 percent consisting of recyclable materials; and


WHEREAS, over the last decade, University Park sanitation employees have collected more than 175,379 tons of solid waste, demonstrating their ongoing commitment to serving our community; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council are grateful for the professionalism, dedication, and service of the City's sanitation personnel;
