Hi Jessica,

We are responding with comments on the proposed improvements to Centennial Park. We currently live at 3632 Purdue St and are under construction at 3705 Haynie Ave, across the street from the park.

- 1. The new monument wall does not fit into the neighborhood:
- a) It is too tall and ruins the park sight-lines. It is visually upsetting to turn left off of Turtle Creek onto Vassar and have the lovely old view blocked. I really miss seeing the field.
- b) It looks like it should belong at SMU. I do not know what the changes are, but I would emphatically say the design missed the mark and should have retained the look and height of the old planter previously there. The other CUP park signage has a unique look and it seems that could have been followed. And perhaps the monument wall not located there, but elsewhere in the park.
- 2. We are against restrooms because they require resources (water and cleaning) and also attract undesirable people and activities. Our former home town, by choice, did not provide permanent restrooms just for this reason. Interestingly, the county park did have restrooms and all the attendant problems.
