**Subject:** CONSIDER AND ACT: on ratification of Tax Year 2023 (FY2024) tax

revenue increase

### Background:

Texas Local Government Code, Section 102.007(c), states that adoption of a budget raising more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year requires a separate vote of the governing body to <u>ratify</u> the property tax increase reflected in the new budget. The vote under this subsection is in addition to and separate from the vote to adopt the budget, or a vote to set the tax rate.

This requirement may be satisfied by reading the following language aloud at the City Council meeting:

"THIS BUDGET WILL RAISE MORE TOTAL PROPERTY TAXES THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET BY \$1,957,621 or 8.4%, AND OF THAT AMOUNT, \$278,651 IS TAX REVENUE TO BE RAISED FROM NEW PROPERTY ADDED TO THE TAX ROLE THIS YEAR."

Once a motion to ratify the increase is made and the vote taken, the Council may move on to consider the ordinance levying the tax rate.

Note: Language substantially similar to the above, as well as the results of the vote, will be added to the cover page of the budget, and posted on the City website.
