Subject: Security and Access Control for the Fondren Building

BACKGROUND:

As part of the remodel of the new public safety building, known as the Fondren Building, the project includes installing interior and exterior security cameras and access control on several doors.

Attached is a quote from the City's access control vendor for the installation of:

- Six exterior cameras
- Four interior cameras
- Access control on ten doors

Given the sensitive contents of the facility and the fact that it will not be regularly occupied, security is a critical component of this project. The proposed system will integrate with the City's existing security infrastructure, ensuring the building is monitored in the same manner as other City facilities through the 24/7 presence of the 911 Dispatch Center.

The total cost of \$88,815.07 includes all materials, labor, and permitting fees required for installation. Work is expected to begin once the general contractor is ready for the security consultant to be on-site and should take approximately two to three weeks to complete.
