SUBJECT: NCTCOG Regional Storm Water Program

BACKGROUND:

In December 2013, the Council authorized the City's participation in a five (5) year Interlocal Agreement with the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) for the Regional Storm Water Management Program for FY13 – FY17. Participation in the program provides municipalities resources for staff and developer training, public education, and guidance with TCEQ mandated annual reporting concerning compliance with the City's Storm Water Management Program (SWMP).

Annual dues associated with the Interlocal Agreement are assessed to each cooperating municipality based on population. The 2014 cost-share for the City is \$2,911.00. Staff anticipates utilizing construction inspection training materials and public education and outreach brochures and currently takes advantage of the information and guidance provided by the Regional Storm Water Management Program.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the authorization letter for participation in the Regional Storm Water Program with NCTCOG and payment for the associated FY2014 Work Program and to authorize the City Manager to execute the letter. Funds are available in the Storm Water Utility Fund annual budget.
