

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS, APPROVING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR COORDINATED HEALTH SERVICES BETWEEN DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS ON BEHALF OF DALLAS COUNTY HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, AND THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING GOODS AND SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code (“Interlocal Cooperation Act”), authorizes local government entities to enter into interlocal contracts for governmental purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Government Code 791.006 specifically authorizes interlocal agreements for the purchase of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, upon full review and consideration of the Interlocal Agreement, the City Council is of the opinion and finds that the terms and conditions of said Agreement should be approved, and that the Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of University Park, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Interlocal Agreement for coordinated health services between Dallas County, Texas on behalf of Dallas County Health and Human Services, and City of University Park, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference, having been reviewed by the City Council of the City of University Park, Texas, and found to be acceptable and in the best interest of the City and its citizens, is hereby in all things approved, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of University Park, Texas.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute any other documents or take any other administrative steps necessary to give effect to this Resolution.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
