A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY DISPATCH SERVICES; MAKING FINDINGS EXEMPTING SUCH CONTRACT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the City employs Emergency Communications Specialists qualified to manage 9-1-1 calls for emergency fire, police, and ambulance services; and

WHEREAS due to challenges in filling the authorized 9-1-1 dispatcher positions, it is necessary to contract with a private company to furnish qualified personnel on a temporary 6 month basis; and

WHEREAS the City desires to contract with ResQ911 to furnish qualified Emergency Communications Specialists to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council finds and determines that the premises hereof are true and correct, and it is necessary to contract with ResQ911 to furnish two (2) qualified personnel on a temporary basis.

SECTION 2. The City Council finds that the service to be purchased through this contract is a procurement necessary to preserve and protect the public health and safety of the City's residents, such exemption being authorized by Sections 252.022 (a) (2) of the Local Government Code.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with ResQ911 as stated in the agreement to furnish two (2) qualified Emergency Communications Specialists for a period of six months from the effective date for a total cost of \$155,600.00. A true copy of the agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," incorporated herein by reference, and made part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
