AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS; MAKING CERTAIN ALLEYS ONE WAY FOR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC BETWEEN SNIDER PLAZA AND HILLCREST AND BETWEEN SNIDER PLAZA AND HURSEY; PROVIDING EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS Section 12.04.001 of the Code of Ordinances authorizes the City Council to designate any street or alley for movement of vehicular traffic in only one direction; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person to drive or operate a motor vehicle at any time southward in the alley between Snider Plaza and Hillcrest in the 6600, 6700, and 6800 blocks.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person to drive or operate a motor vehicle at any time northward in the alley between Snider Plaza and Hursey in the 6600, 6700, 6800, 6900, and 7000 blocks.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to emergency vehicles. In addition, the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to Sanitation vehicles performing City services in the alley between Snider Plaza and Hillcrest in the 6600 block between 6:30 – 7:30 a.m.

SECTION 4. That Ordinance Number 26-004 and all other ordinances of the City of University Park in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof, other than the part decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction in the municipal court of the City of University Park, Texas, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law and Charter in such cases provide. The restrictions set out herein shall not be effective until appropriate signs giving notice thereof shall have been erected as provided by the Code of Ordinances indicating the alleys designated herein to be one way for vehicular traffic.
