INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT FOR JOINT PROVISION OF SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD SERVICES

This interlocal cooperation agreement ("Agreement") is entered into on April 12,2016 (date), between the Highland Park Independent School District ("District"), the City of University Park, Texas ("City") the Town of Highland Park, Texas ("Town") (individually a "party" and collectively "the parties").

BACKGROUND

- The Texas State Legislature has authorized the use of interlocal cooperation Agreements between governmental entities for the provision of governmental services and functions.
- This Agreement is made under the authority of the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 791, and is related to the joint authorization by District, the City and the Town to provide certain public safety services.
- The governmental entities find that the performance of this Agreement is in their common public interest, and that the services provided pursuant to this Agreement will benefit the citizens of the District, the City and the Town.
- The parties, in expending funds in the performance of the governmental functions under this Agreement, will make payments only from current revenues legally available to such party.

AGREEMENTS

Purpose

I. The purpose of this Agreement is to provide school crossing guard services ("Services") by the District, the City and the Town for the various District campuses. The parties agree that it is to their mutual benefit and the benefit of their citizenry to enter into this Agreement. The health, safety, and welfare of the students of the District and the citizens of the City and the Town will be benefited.

Term

II. This Agreement will start on the first day of the District's 2016-2017 school year and end on the last day of the District's 2016-2017 school year. This Agreement will automatically renew for the next school year, unless canceled by any of the parties by giving ninety (90) days written notice to the other parties, but at no time can this Agreement be canceled during the District's school year.

Personnel Provided

- III. The District will provide crossing guards to perform the Services at the locations where the District, after consultation with the Town and the City, determines that their presence is necessary for the safety of children crossing public streets. Services will be provided before and after school hours on the days the schools are in session. The school crossing guard locations are listed in Exhibit A to this Agreement.
- IV. On an annual basis, no later than the beginning of a new school year, the District will propose to the City and the Town crossing guard locations for the upcoming school year for approval. The City or the Town will not unreasonably withhold approval of the District's recommendations.

Contracting For Service

V. District may contract with an independent contractor ("Contractor") to provide the Services. The Contractor will be under the full control and supervision of the District. Selection of Contractor shall be at the sole discretion of the District. Complaints or problems with the Services will be directed to the District. In the event of unresolved disputes, the District shall have final authority.

Compensation

VI. The City and the Town will pay the District, in advance at the beginning of the school year, one hundred percent (100%) of the actual expenses incurred in the prior school year (the "Advanced Payment"). In the event that the District's actual expenses in a given school year exceed the Advanced Payment, the Town and the City will reimburse the District for the overage at the end of the school year. The City and the Town will allocate the amounts paid to the District under this Agreement based upon a ratio of the number of school crossing guard locations within their boundaries to the total number of locations.

Payment Schedule

VII. Payment for Services shall be made to the District by the City and the Town annually. The District will submit a bill for the Advanced Payment to the City and the Town by the first day of school, and payment will be due not later than sixty days later. The District will submit a bill for amounts in excess of the Advanced Payment within thirty days after the end of the school year and payment will be due not later than sixty days later.

Scheduling

VIII. The City and the Town will provide police officers to act as substitute crossing guards for locations within their boundaries if the Contractor is unable to promptly provide replacement personnel. The City and the Town will provide temporary crossing guards at no charge to the District.

General Requirements

- A. Immunity: Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to affect, alter, or modify the sovereign immunity of either party under the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code §§101.001 et seq. The parties expressly understand and agree that by entering into this Agreement, neither the District, the City nor the Town waives, nor shall be deemed to waive, any immunity or defense that would otherwise be available to each against claims arising in the exercise of its governmental powers and functions.
- B. Insurance: During the term of this Agreement, District agrees to obtain and maintain, as part of the cost of providing the Services, general liability insurance naming the City and the Town as additional insured with respect to the District providing the Services. The District will furnish the City and the Town with a certificate of insurance in accordance with this paragraph within sixty (60) days from the date of execution of this Agreement. Cost for the certificate of insurance will be included in the amount of expense paid to the District by the City and the Town. Nothing in this Agreement will be construed to grant any third party rights or waive the governmental or public purpose of the provision of the Service described in this Agreement. The City and the Town may also have its own insurance, at its own expense, for any potential liability for such Services.
- C. Third Parties: This Agreement does not create any third-party beneficiaries. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create, expand or form a basis for liability to any third party under any theory of law against the District, the City or the Town.
- D. Notice: Each notice or other communication which may be or is required to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been properly given when delivered personally during the normal business hours of the party to whom such communication is directed, or upon receipt when sent by United States registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, to the appropriate one of the following addresses as may be designated by the appropriate party; however, each party has a right to designate a different address by giving the other party fifteen (15) days prior written notice of such designation:

- E. Management Authority: During the term of this Agreement District agrees to provide adequate supervision and oversight of the Contractor.
- F. Accountability: District agrees to furnish upon the request of the City and/or the Town copies of reports of daily activity submitted by Contractor. District also agrees to furnish upon the request of the City and/or the Town any and all aggregate or statistical information created by District to document, track, or report activities of the Contractor.
- **G.** Claims Against Parties: Each party shall be responsible for defending or disposing of all claims arising against the respective party as a result of services provided pursuant to this Agreement.
- H. Entire Agreement: This Agreement contains the entire Agreement of the parties, and no other oral or written commitments shall have any force or effect if not contained in this Agreement.
- I. Severability: In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement are for any reason held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of this Agreement, and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalidity, illegality or unenforceable provision had never been contained in this Agreement.
- J. Authority: The signatories to this Agreement are authorized to execute this contract on behalf of the parties they purport to represent, and each party certifies to the other, that any necessary resolutions extending such authority have been duly passed by the respective governing bodies and are now in full force and effect.
- K. Applicable Law: This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Texas and venue of any action brought to enforce the terms hereof shall lie exclusively in Dallas County, Texas.
- L. Execution: This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and constitute one and the same instrument.
