Subject: Consider an ordinance amending Section 13.05.031 of the Code of Ordinances to provide clarity on the definition of an approved container

Background:

The current Code of Ordinances for the City defines an approved garbage container as "A container constructed of metal or plastic or other substantial material, with handles sufficiently strong for workers to empty the garbage or trash from the container conveniently. The container shall not exceed a capacity of thirty-two (32) gallons or a weight of fifty (50) pounds when filled and shall be equipped with a tight-fitting lid or cover. Where trash is placed adjacent to the alley for collection, the lid shall be attached to a rack, pole, fence, or other permanent structure by a metal cable, chain, or other means so it remains at the storage place for the container."

There has been some confusion caused by the use of the word "or" when describing the approved size and weight of the container. Staff wishes to clarify that an approved garbage container should not exceed 32 gallons *and* should not weigh more than 50 pounds when filled. The proposed amending ordinance would revise the definition to replace the word "or" with "and".
