Subject: Consider Appointing Members to the Snider Plaza Employee Parking Task Force

Background:

At the October 3, 2023 City Council meeting, City staff introduced a discussion regarding identifying solutions for employee parking in Snider Plaza. At its meeting, City staff proposed a task force be created to provide a recommendation to the City Council in regards to employee parking at Snider Plaza. The charge to this task force would be to provide a recommendation to the City Council on the best option for off-site parking for employees of Snider Plaza and how to pay for this off-site parking.

After the October 3rd City Council meeting, suggestions were received for members to serve on this task force that included property owners, merchants and residents that lived near Snider Plaza. City staff is recommending that the City Council consider appointments to Snider Plaza Employee Parking Task Force.

The recommended timeline for the work of this Task Force is intended to coincide with the beginning of surface improvements at Snider Plaza for the approved scope of this project. The recommended timeline for the Snider Plaza Employee Parking Task Force is listed below.

- November 2023: Appoint members
- December 2023/January 2024: Initial meeting of the task force
- April 2024: Task force concludes work and presents recommendation to the City Council
