A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE DALLAS COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION ACTION PLAN UPDATE 2025; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS** the City Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City of University Park; and

**WHEREAS** Dallas County has prepared and adopted a multi-hazard mitigation plan, titled the "Dallas County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan Update 2025" (Haz MAP 2025) in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

**WHEREAS** the Haz MAP 2025 identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Dallas County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

**WHEREAS** adoption by the City of University Park demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Haz MAP 2025; Now Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the Haz MAP 2025 promulgated by Dallas County is hereby approved and adopted by the City of University Park. The Haz MAP 2025 is incorporated herein by reference and the title page is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof for all purposes. This Plan may be edited or amended after submission for review but will not require the re-adoption of any further iterations. This only applies to this specific Plan and does not absolve the City from updating the Plan in five years.

The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to take such other administrative steps as may be necessary to fulfill the City's responsibilities outlined in the Haz MAP 2025.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
