Mark and Laurie Connell, property owners at 7320 Turtle Creek Blvd, City of University Park requesting a variance under Section 28-105 (3) (a) to allow a 6 feet high decorative wrought iron fence to extend 10 feet in the required front yard. The comprehensive zoning ordinance allows a decorative fence not exceeding 5 feet in height, architecturally attached to the main building to extend up to 6 feet in the required front yard. The subject property is located at 7320 Turtle Creek Boulevard and zoned Single Family "SF-4" zoning district classification in accordance with the comprehensive zoning ordinance.
