



Proposal for the City of University Park

Overview

Brentwood Public Affairs proposes to represent the City of University Park before the Texas Legislature, and any other relevant agency that may arise. The stated goal is to work with the legislature to attempt to ensure passage of a bill *relating to administration of certain retirement systems under the Texas Local Fire Fighters Retirement Act and to participation in the Texas Municipal Retirement System.*

Statement of Work

- Work with legislators in passing, amending or defeating legislation, as directed by the City of University Park.
- Maintain a continuing relationship with legislators, key officers and employees of the Texas House and Senate on the City of University Park's behalf.
- Provide regular status reports on activities and legislative actions; Make introductions and set up meetings with key stakeholders in relative agencies and key legislative committees.
- Attend legislative committee hearings, daily sessions of the House and Senate, and report key information to the City of University Park.
- Identify 3rd party groups/companies/people that could possibly support our issue.
- Advise the City of University Park on and participate in the preparation and submission of testimony before legislative committees and state agencies.
