SUBJECT: 2017 Sanitation Franchises Amendment

BACKGROUND:

On January 17, 2017, the City Council approved the ordinance granting franchises to 4 companies wishing to engage in the business of collecting, transporting, and disposing of solid waste using stationary compactors, discarded tire containers, portable toilets, and/or construction roll-off containers from commercial and industrial premises and development projects within the City. An amendment to the ordinance granting a franchise to ServAll was approved on 2/7/17. Since the February 7, 2017 amendment, we've received additional requests for sanitation franchises.

The attached ordinance grants a franchise to S&H Waste Disposal, Supreme Recycling, Hart Brothers, DB Disposal Services, HD Waste & Recycling, Empire Disposal, and Maldonado Discount Waste, in addition to the five (5) previously approved companies, to conduct business in the City through December 31, 2017.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends City Council approval of the ordinance granting a franchise to S&H Waste Disposal, Supreme Recycling, Hart Brothers, DB Disposal Services, HD Waste & Recycling, Empire Disposal and Maldonado Discount Waste in addition to those companies previously authorized.
