WHEREAS, public works infrastructure, facilities and services are vital to the health, safety and well-being of the residents of the City of University Park; and

WHEREAS, such facilities and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, engineers and administrators who are responsible for building, operating and maintaining the public works systems that serve our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the American Public Works Association instituted Public Works Week as a public education campaign "to inform communities and their leaders on the importance of our nation's public infrastructure and public works services"; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has 80 staff members with 1,138 combined years of service to the City of University Park; and

WHEREAS, these professionals maintain more than 6,000 traffic signs, 33 traffic signals, and 113 decorative street lights; maintain and repair 89 miles of water mains, 63 miles of sanitary sewer mains, 25 miles of storm sewer, and 2 elevated water storage tanks; and collect and dispose of garbage, yard waste, and recycling from more than 8,300 homes and businesses.
