SUBJECT: No Parking along the west curb line of Williams Parkway

BACKGROUND:

During the McFarlin Bridge project, temporary ordinances were put in place to prohibit parking along the west curb line of the 6400 block of Williams Parkway between McFarlin Boulevard and University Boulevard. This measure was taken to improve traffic flow and provide better access for emergency vehicles. During these restrictions, staff received no complaints or notices of concern from the residents of Williams Parkway. Because of the traffic improvements realized during the temporary restrictions, staff recommends designating the west curb line of the 6400 block of Williams Parkway No Parking Anytime.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends City Council approval of the ordinance establishing No Parking Anytime along the west curb line of Williams Parkway between McFarlin Boulevard and University Boulevard.
