SUBJECT: 2017 Sanitation Franchise Amendment

BACKGROUND:

On January 17, 2017, the City Council approved the ordinance granting franchises to 4 companies wishing to engage in the business of collecting, transporting, and disposing of solid waste using stationary compactors, discarded tire containers, portable toilets, and/or construction roll-off containers from commercial and industrial premises and development projects within the City. An amendment to the ordinance was approved on 2/7/17 and subsequent amendments on 3/7/17, 4/18/17, and 5/16/17. Since the May 16, 2017 amendment, we've received an additional request for a sanitation franchise.

The attached ordinance grants a franchise to Fusion Waste and Recycling, in addition to the fourteen (14) previously approved companies, to conduct business in the City through December 31, 2017.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends City Council approval of the ordinance granting a franchise to Fusion Waste and Recycling in addition to those companies previously authorized.
