## COST SHARING AGREEMENT

This Cost Sharing Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is entered into as of the date of execution by and between the City of University Park, Texas (hereinafter the "City") and the Town of Highland Park, Texas (hereinafter "Town"), both home-rule municipalities of Dallas County, Texas, as follows:

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Town are entering into a Technical Services Agreement with Black & Veatch Corporation regarding the radio communication systems for the City and Town (the "TSA"); and

WHEREAS, the TSA includes a total project cost of approximately \$85,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City and Town wish to cooperate and coordinate as to the costs of the TSA subject to the following terms and conditions:

## AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants of the parties set forth in this Agreement, and for other good and valuable consideration the receipt and adequacy of which are acknowledged and agreed by the City and Town, the City and Town agree as follows:

- 1. The City and Town agree to share the costs of the TSA on a 50/50 basis, with each entity paying fifty percent (50%) of the costs of the TSA.
- 2. The City and Town agree to make their proportionate payments to Black and Veatch Corporation in accordance with the TSA.
- **3**. Miscellaneous:
  - a. This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the written consent of the other party.
  - b. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the matters contained herein and may not be modified or terminated except upon the provisions hereof or by the mutual written agreement of the parties hereto.
  - c. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and shall be performable in Dallas County, Texas.

- d. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
- e. The parties agree this Agreement has been drafted jointly by the parties and their legal representatives.
