WHEREAS, the City of University Park has planted an estimated 3,900 trees since 1982 when the “Trees for Town” program was first established; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day serves as a symbol to encourage University Park residents to plant a tree as a reminder of our nation’s forests and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Arbor Day Celebration, the Parks Department will plant a tree with the aid of students from the Highland Park Independent School District; and

WHEREAS, the City of University Park has been designated as a Tree City USA community by the National Arbor Day Foundation for the 12th consecutive year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Olin Lane of the City of University Park, Texas do hereby proclaim, Friday, November 3, 2017 as “Arbor Day” within the City of University Park, Texas.
