On behalf of the Park Cities Historic and Preservation Society, we want to thank you for your help in hosting the Second Annual Classic & Antique Car Show. We are so pleased that this event has continued to grow and attribute much of the success to our partnership with you and the City of University Park. Last year we had more than 150 entries and a tremendous attendance from the community. Our neighbors to Burleson Park were notified in advance of the show and were very supportive of the event and many attended the show. We have posted to our Facebook page @ PCHPS Classic and Antique Car Show a video of the day as well as photos of the event and hope you will see what we the day offered the community.

It is our hope to host the third annual show in Burleson Park on April 21, 2018 with a rain date of April 28, 2018. Our event would begin setting up at 8:00am and the show will run from 10am-4pm. As we did for last year's show, we would like to close Daniel from Durham to Dublin on the north side of the park and barricade off the parking slip area of Dublin on the east side of the park, from University to Daniel again. We would like to also close the block of University between Dublin and Durham to safe-guard pedestrian traffic as this worked very well last year. We have been most fortunate to have the cooperation of the SMU traffic department for the use of the parking lot south of the park and as in years past, they are willing to help us with the logistics for the 2018 show. We will also secure the help of two off-duty police officers to help with traffic that day.

As is our tradition, admission to the show will be free to the public. The registration fee for cars and trucks will be \$35 and all proceeds will benefit the Park Cities Historic and Preservation Society to benefit our scholarship fund at Highland Park High School. The event will include a trophy presentation, food and drinks. We hope that you will plan to join us for this event, a true community celebration of classic cars and those who enjoy them.
