As part of the 2016 bond program the existing Seay Center currently located on this property was moved to Glenwick Ave to make room for the new Natatorium/Professional Development Center. This is new building is replacing the aging pool and provide new professional development spaces as that activity is currently being done at other school campuses. The building will also include athletic director office spaces and baseball locker rooms moved from the stadium.

The existing Seay Center will be demolished and the new Multi-Use building will be constructed.
