**SUBJECT:** Consider Resolution Amending the City Manager's Change Order

Authority

## **BACKGROUND:**

On August 21, 2018, Council approved staff's request to adjust the City Manager's Change Order Authority.

- The current Administrative Order # FNC-1 states that the City Manager may approve Change Orders of up to \$30,000.00 or 25% of the original contract amount, whichever is lower.
- The newly approved policy states that "The City Manager is granted general authority to approve a change order ... if the change order involves a decrease or an increase not exceeding the monetary limit set forth in Section 252.048 of the Local Government Code in effect at the time of the change order."

Section 252.048 of the current Local Government Code sets the maximum Change Order limit at \$50,000.00 or 25% of the original contract amount, whichever is lower.

A resolution with the newly approved language is attached. If Council approves this resolution, staff will update the City's Administrative Orders and purchasing policies to reflect this change.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that Council approve the resolution to give the City Manager the Change Order authority matching Texas Local Government Code, Section 252.048.
