A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS FOR CITY CONTRACTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City enters contracts for the purchase of goods and services as authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has granted authority to the City Manager to approve change orders to such contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to update the authority in accordance with applicable state law; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNIVERSITY PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That changes in plans or specifications are necessary after the performance of a contract is begun or if it is necessary to decrease or increase the quantity of work to be performed or of materials, equipment, or supplies to be furnished, the City Council may approve change orders.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is granted general authority to approve a change order to a contract for a purpose set out in Section 1 hereof if the change order involves a decrease or an increase not exceeding the monetary limit set forth in Section 252.048 of the Local Government Code in effect at the time of the change order.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is directed to revise section FNC-1 of the Administrative Orders to reflect this change of authority to approve change orders.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
