SUBJECT: "LOVE" Sculpture Donation – Recommended Location

BACKGROUND:

On August 7, 2018, City Council approved the "LOVE" sculpture donation from longtime resident Pauline Neuhoﬀ and family, which was created by the renowned artist Robert Indiana.

During the August 2018 meeting, City Council directed staff to review potential locations for the sculpture with a committee of community representatives. The committee has met on two separate occasions including a tour to review location options. The criteria used to review each location included the sculptures location, installation logistics, visibility, accessibility and security.

The location that the majority of the committee supports is located at the south end of the Williams Park Island, with the sculpture facing north.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council consider approval of the recommended sculpture location, authorizing staff to proceed with the project.
